## ZERO TO THREE Certified Trainer: *DC:0-5*<sup>™</sup> Certification Criteria and Application Overview



There are two stages of ZERO TO THREE Trainer Certifications: Stage 1. Provisional Trainer; and Stage 2. Certified Trainer. ZERO TO THREE digital Membership is included in both stages of certification. This overview summarizes the ZERO TO THREE Certified Trainer: *DC:0-5<sup>TM</sup>* timeframe, criteria, and evidence options by certification stage. This page outlines the first steps of Provisional Trainer application; page 2 outlines the final part of Provisional Trainer Certification followed by Certified Trainer information.
